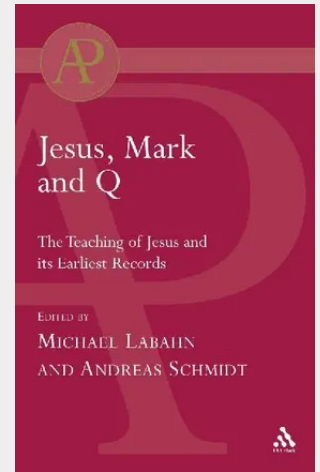


Jesus, Mark and Q
