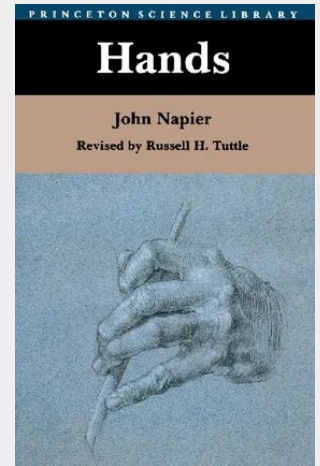


Hands
