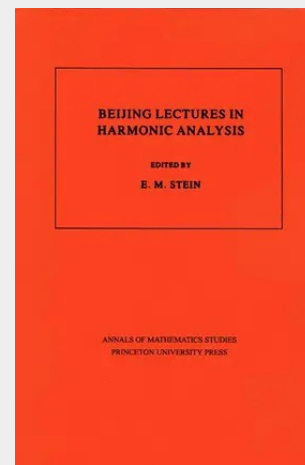


Beijing Lectures in Harmonic Analysis
