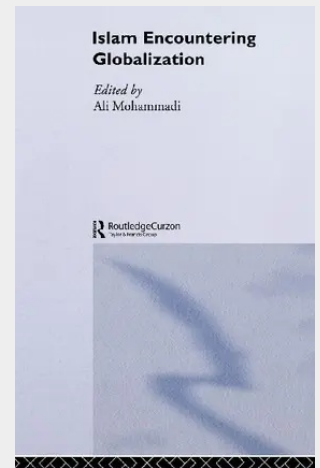


Islam Encountering Globalisation
