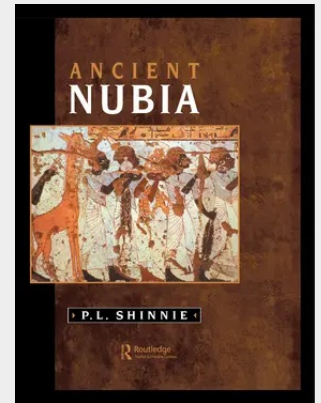


Ancient Nubia
