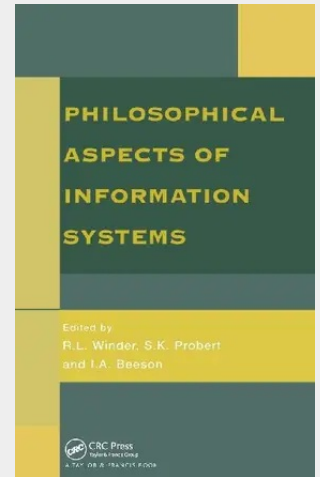


Philosophical Issues In Information Systems
