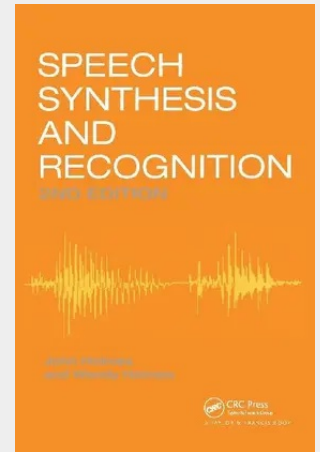


Speech Synthesis and Recognition
