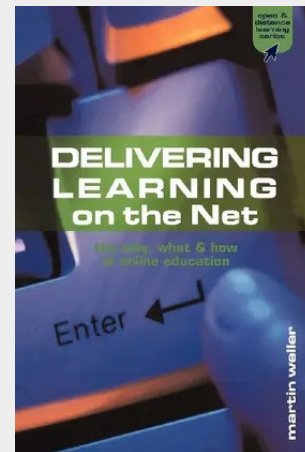


Delivering Learning on the Net
