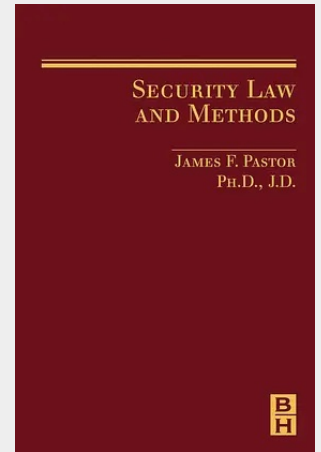


Security Law and Methods
