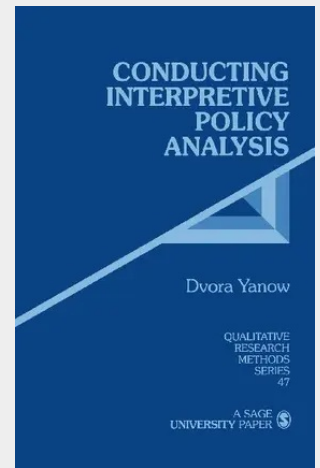


Conducting Interpretive Policy Analysis
