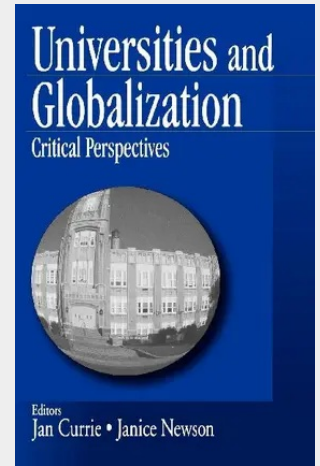


Universities and Globalization
