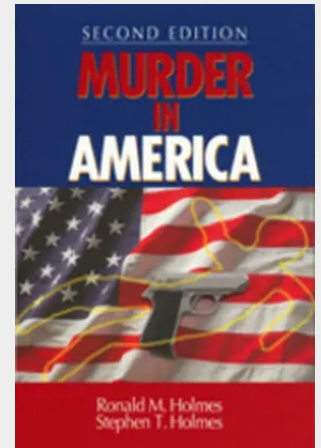


Murder in America
