

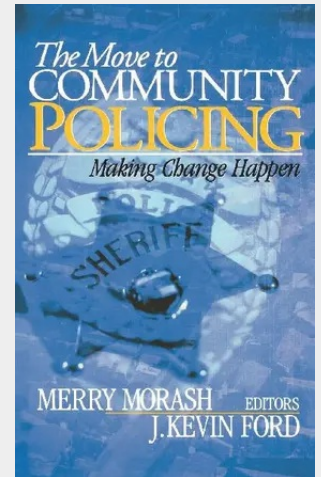
The Move to Community Policing
