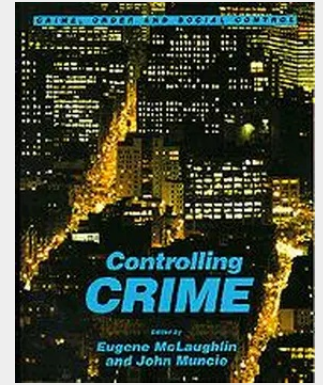


## Controlling Crime
