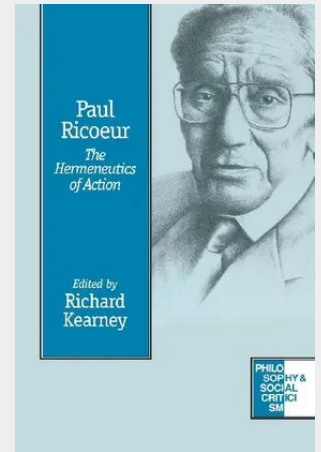
## Paul Ricoeur
