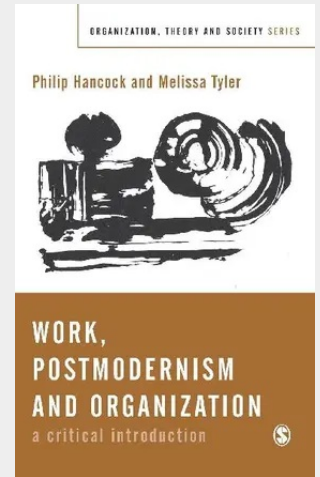


Work, Postmodernism and Organization
