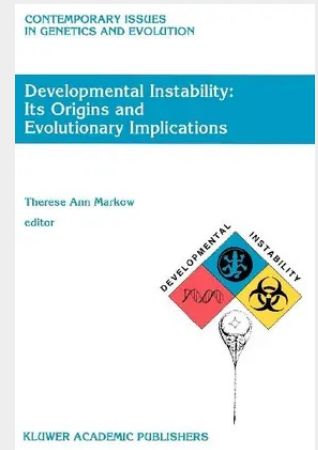


Developmental Instability: Its Origins and Evolutionary Implications
