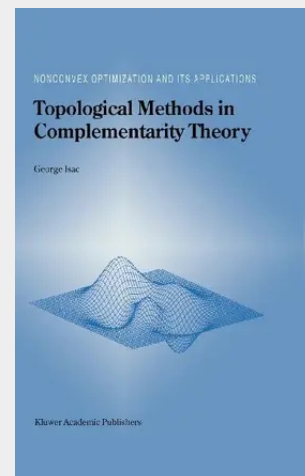


Topological Methods in Complementarity Theory
