

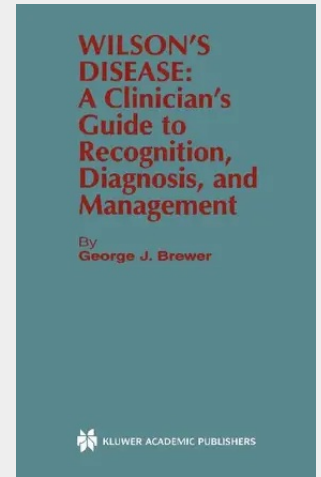
Wilson's Disease
