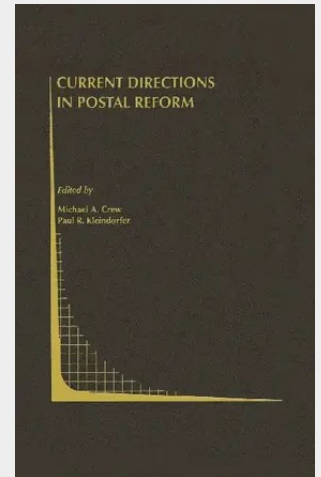


Current Directions in Postal Reform
