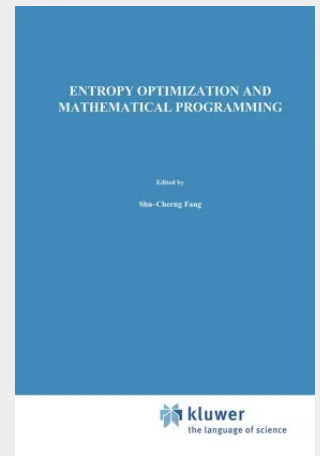


Entropy Optimization and Mathematical Programming
