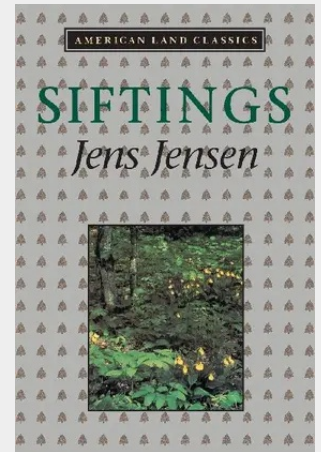


Jensen
