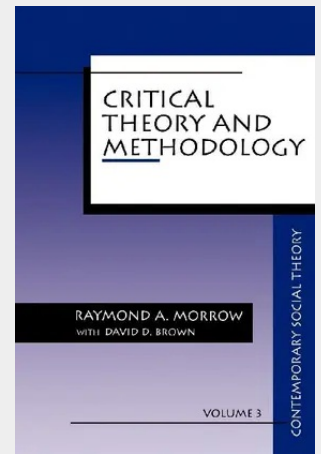


Critical Theory and Methodology
