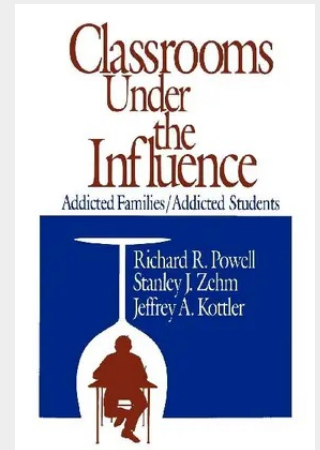


Classrooms Under the Influence
