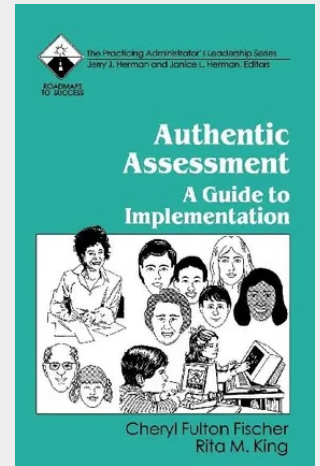


Authentic Assessment
