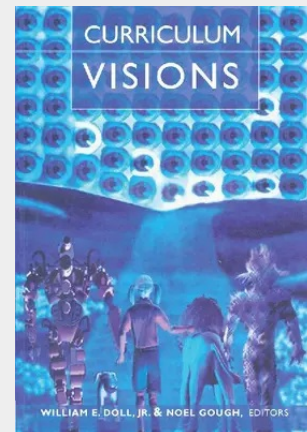


Curriculum Visions
