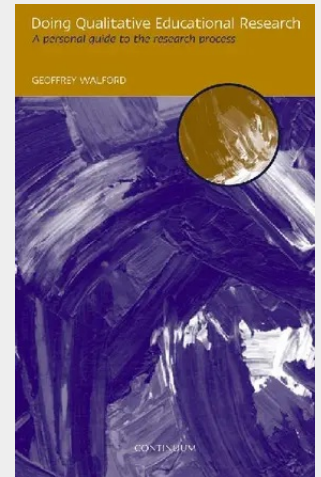


Walford
