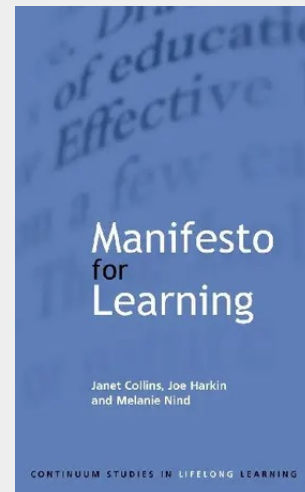


Manifesto for Learning

What makes people learn effectively? What can we do to promote more effective learning?
