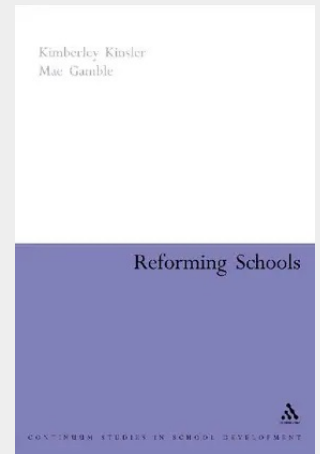


Reforming Schools
