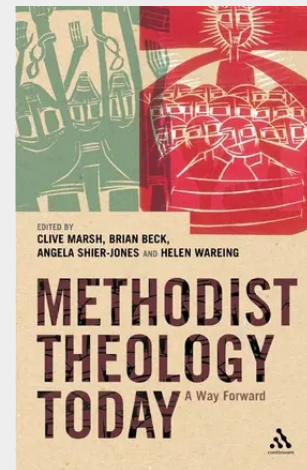


## Unmasking Methodist Theology
