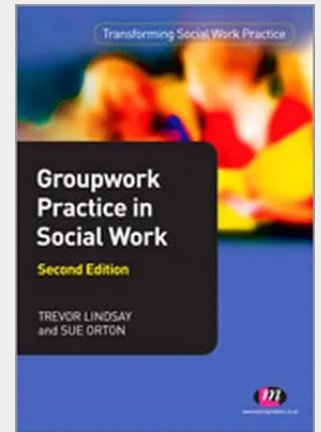


Groupwork Practice in Social Work
