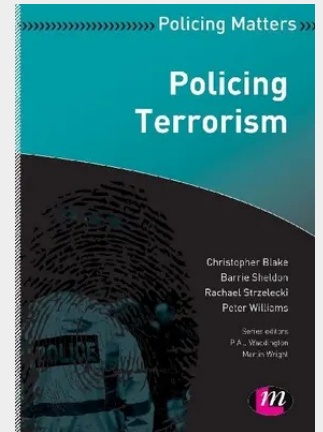


Policing Terrorism
