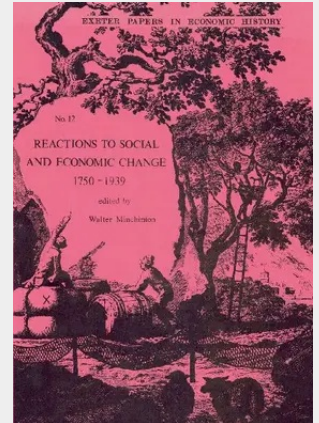


Reactions to Social and Economic Change 1750-1939
