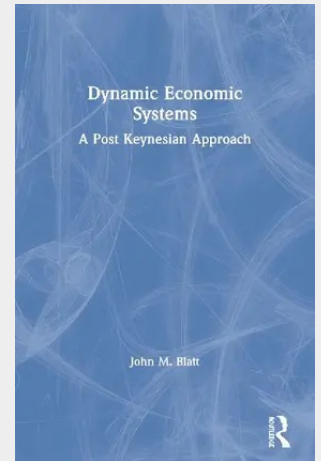


Dynamic Economic Systems
