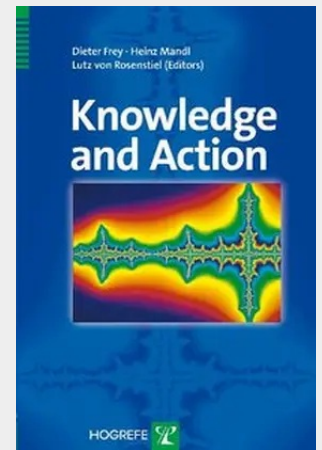


Knowledge and Action
