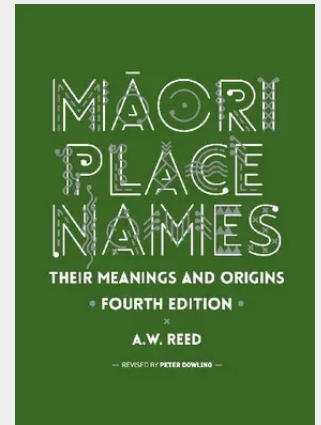


Māori Place Names
