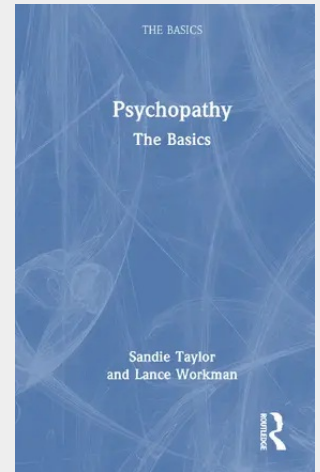


Psychopathy
