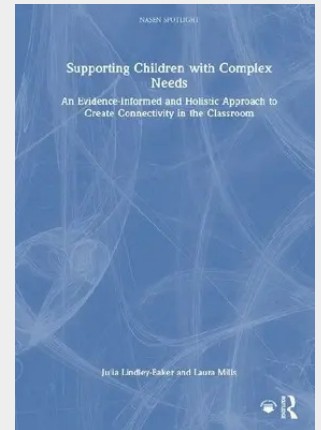


Supporting Children with Complex Needs
