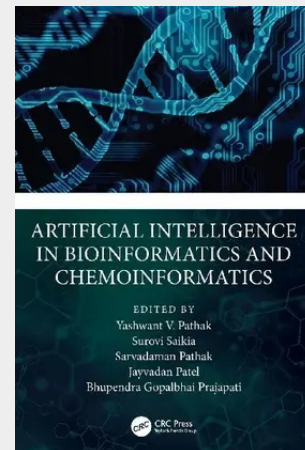


Artificial Intelligence in Bioinformatics and Chemoinformatics
