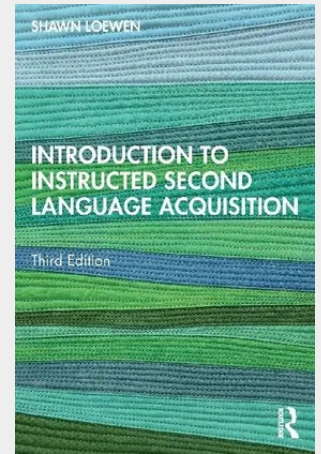


Introduction to Instructed Second Language Acquisition
