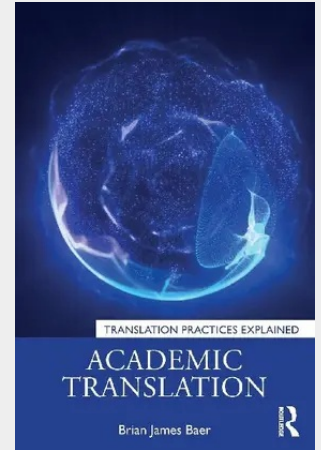


Academic Translation
