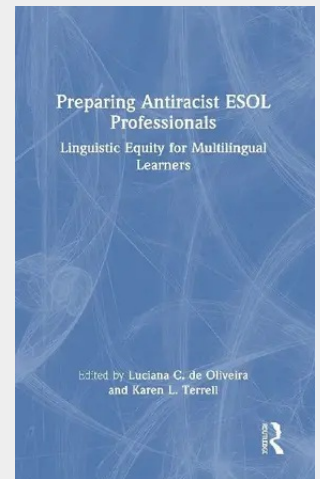


Preparing Antiracist ESOL Professionals
