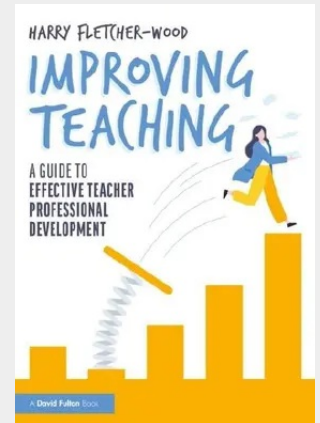


Improving Teaching
