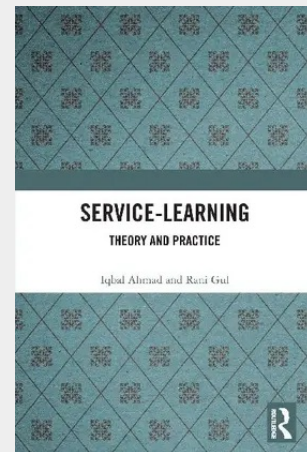


Service-Learning
