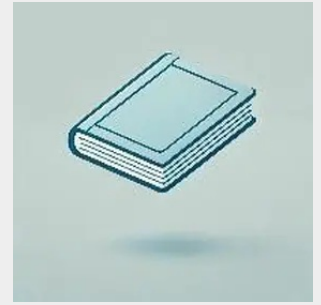


The Neurodiversity Toolkit

A chapter focuses on screening and the diagnostic process, acknowledging the emotional rollercoaster than this may cause and signposting readers to support. It provides tips on how to study effectively, including the use of technology and equipment that may help and how to manage challenges that may be experienced when learning and working in practice settings. Including vignettes from neurodivergent people throughout, it is accessible and engaging, presenting information for a variety of learning styles. The book is an essential guide for neurodivergent health and social care professionals throughout their career from students onwards.
