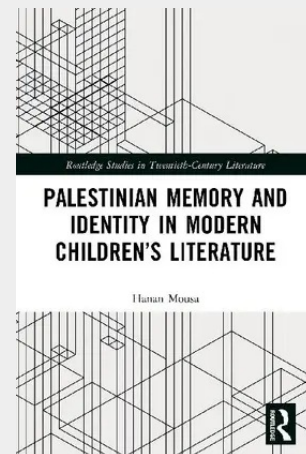


Palestinian Memory and Identity in Modern Children's Literature
