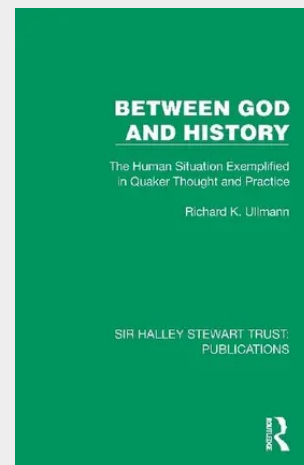


Between God and History
