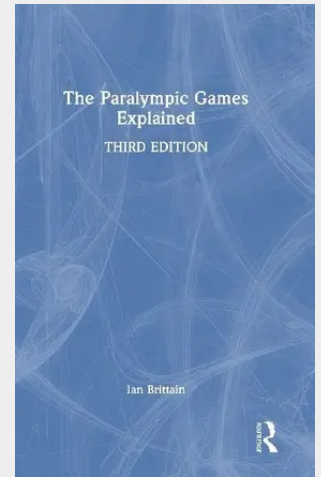


The Paralympic Games Explained
