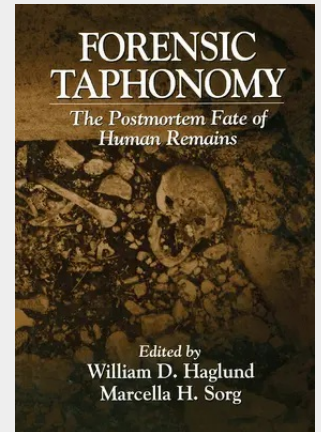


Forensic Taphonomy
