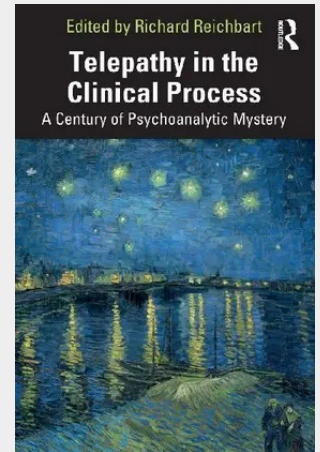


Telepathy in the Clinical Process
